So when Mary "leaves the room" we talk about her; that is, we praise her, interested in that exuberance and proactive style we observe even now into her late eighties. We want to be like her! Mary would rather talk about the accomplishments of her large family and classmates. But the inquiries and questions we get from lots of ladies in the Association about Mary Brennan have motivated us to give her some limelight in this newsletter.

Following graduation from Holy Name School, Mary went on to St. Xavier Academy in Providence. (With her loyal classmates she looks forward to celebrating

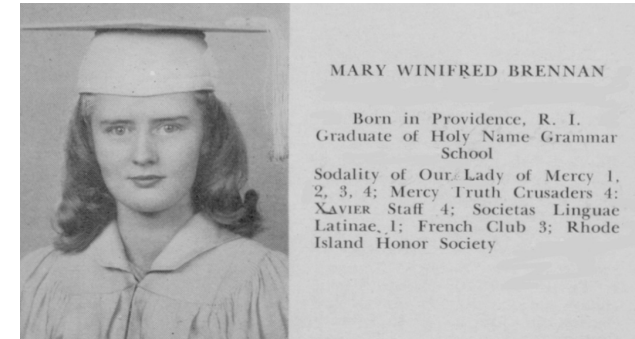
her 70th alumnae SXA reunion in 2016.)

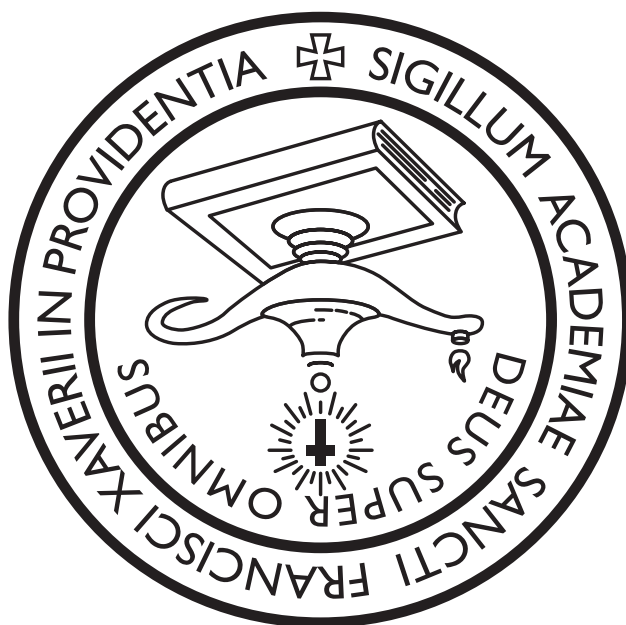
